WORKSHOPS' RATIONALE AND FUNCTIONING

- The workshops are intended to be an opportunity to share scientific advances, to encourage the establishment of collaborations and to identify possibilities for joint responses to international calls for projects and theses co-supervision.
- After the workshops, a joint publication will be produced (E-Book format, with ISSN or DOI), as an output of the presentations and discussions held.

Workshops Part I - Researchers' Presentations

- Will be moderated by the Chair, who will be responsible for introducing the participants, managing the time of presentations and moderating the Q&A session.
- Participants will be able to present their work/results in their field of research (~ 30 minutes), followed by Q&A session. The audience is also invited to participate actively in the Q&A session.

Workshops Part II - Debate Session/round-table

- The Workshops Part II will be held in a "round-table" format, managed by the Moderator.
- The debate within each Workshop aims at i) discussing issues raised in Workshops Part I (morning sessions), and others the Moderator and participants consider relevant, and ii) identify research challenges or topics of concern and awareness in each scientific area. The audience is also invited to participate actively in the discussion by proposing debate questions and participating in the Q&A session.

Joint Debate with all participants (19th of April)

- This session will take place at the Auditorium 8.1 (Faculty of Engineering), and it will be opened to all participants.
- The session will include presentations from the three UBI Moderators, who will summarize the discussions/conclusions from the previous day's Workshops.
- It will also include an open session of Q&A, for debating common research challenges, identifying areas of interdisciplinarity, common concerns, issues of awareness needs, etc...

E-BOOK - Joint publication

- After the Re-UNITA Workshops, a joint publication will be produced, as an output of the presentations and discussions held during the event.
- The publication will have the format of an **E-Book with ISSN or DOI**.
- Each participant should send his/her **contribution** by e-mail to **natalia.alves@ubi.pt**.
- Contributions from Part I (Researchers' Presentations): ~ 4000 words.
- Contributions from Part II (Round-table): ~ 1000 words of introduction from each Moderator and ~1000 words from each participant based on what they discussed.
- **Deadline for sending contributions => April 30th.**
